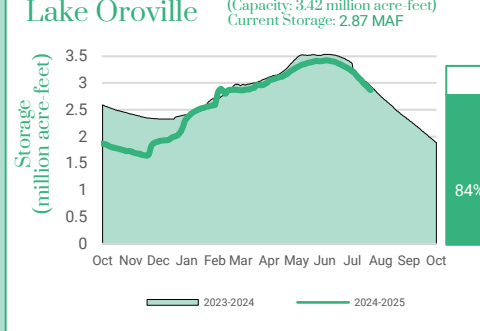

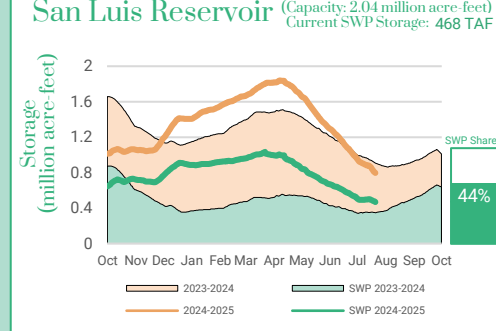
## 8 Station Index Rain

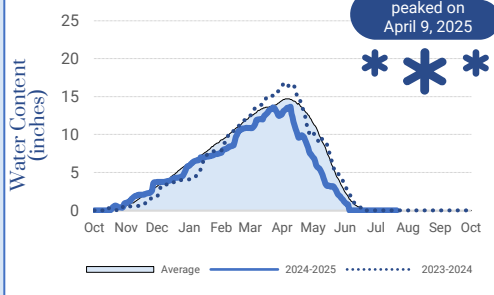

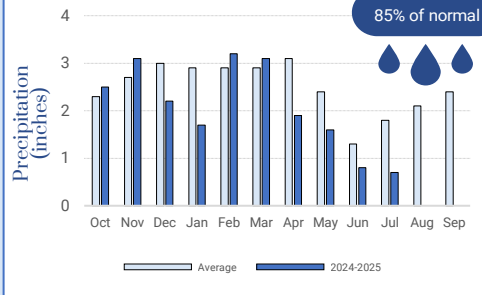

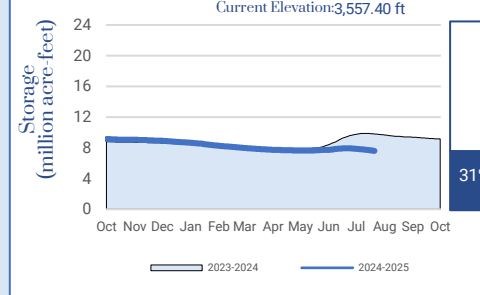
## Colorado River Basin Snow



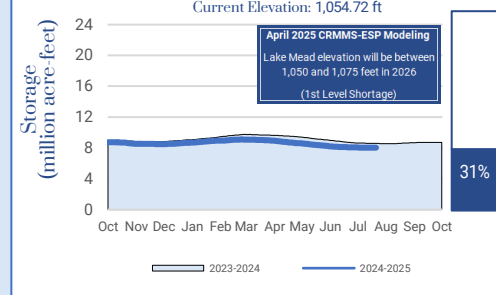
